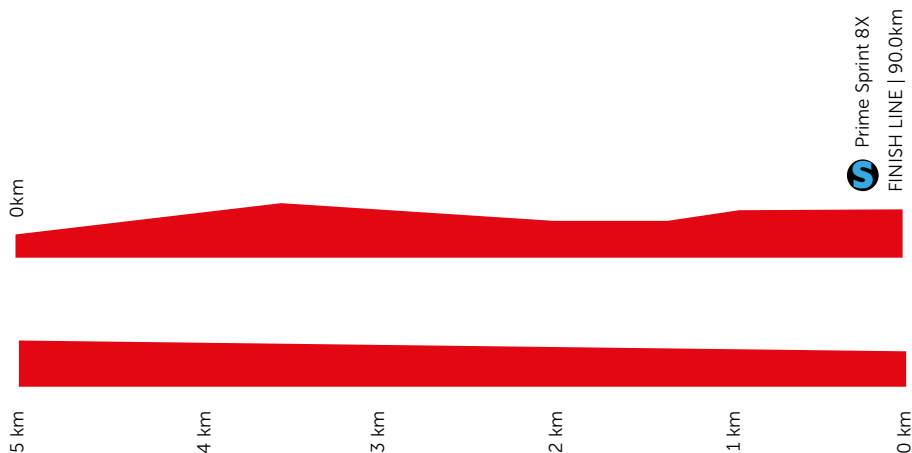
## Overall Map

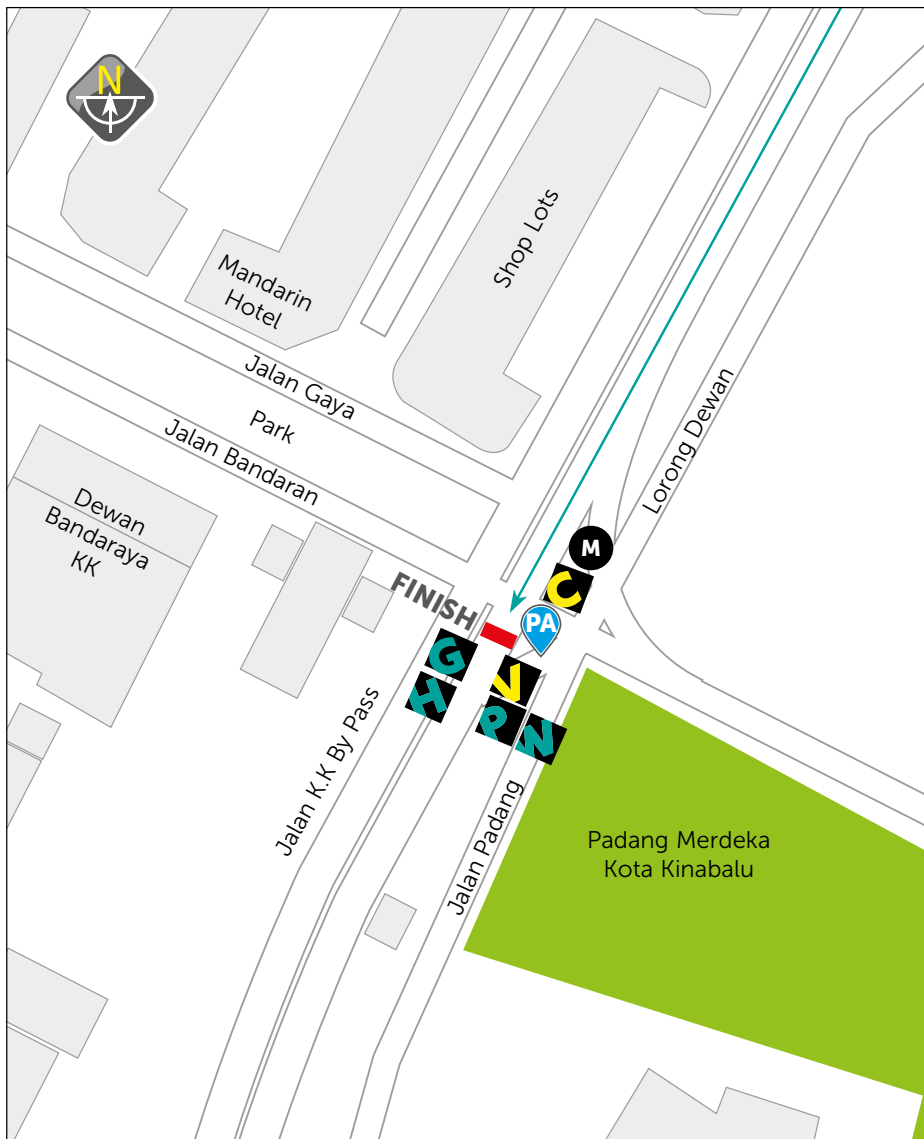

### ARTICLE 1. ORGANISATION

### ARTICLE 2. TYPE OF EVENT

The event is open to athletes of the Men's Elite and Under 23 categories. The event is entered on the UCI Asia Calendar and is registered as a class Criterium.

### ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPATION

The fact of entering and or/participating in the event implies that each team/rider fully accepts all the provisions laid out in these Specific Regulations and undertakes to respect them.

### ARTICLE 4. PRE RACE AND RACE HEADQUARTERS

Prior to the event, the race headquarters shall be open starting from 1st of January to the 2nd of February 2020 from 09.00hrs to 19.00hrs and located at the following address:

**Team representatives and or riders are requested to confirm their starters and collect their race numbers from 15.00hrs to 16.45hrs on 5th of February 2020 at Orkid Room, Level 1, Promenade Hotel Kota Kinabalu, Sabah**

(Managers and Riders are kindly reminded to bring along their 2020 licenses and Team Jersey for inspection)

Signing on Riders will be expected to sign on from 07.15 to 08.20hrs

### ARTICLE 5. RADIO-TOUR

Race information will be broadcast in English on the Radio Tour channel for the Technical following vehicles.

### ARTICLE 6. NEUTRAL TECHNICAL SUPPORT

The technical support service is handled by Le Tour de Langkawi Neutral Service

Neutral Support will be, by means of 3 Sedan Cars and will carry 11 and 12 speed wheels as spare wheels for Shimano and Campagnolo. Disc brake wheels will also be carried.

There will be a Techniacl Zone for Service and feeding located after the Finish Line but no neutralisation or lap out will be given.

### ARTICLE 7. FEEDING/SERVICE AREA

Please note feeding in the Feed Zones or at all times on foot, will be on the left side of the road only.

On the Circuit a location just after the Finish Line will be advised for static feeding

and Race Service. Neutral Support will also carry Bidons and water to assist the riders.

### ARTICLE 8. CRITERIUM CIRCUIT

The Race is 9 laps of a 10km circuit for a Total distance of 90kms. The Race will start with Neutralised section of approximately 500 meters.

The Commissaires shall take all measures needed to ensure the race be run properly, particularly change of race situation on the circuit, and lapped riders.

### ARTICLE 9: CLASSIFICATIONS

Prizes will be awarded to the first 20 placed riders. Primes will be awarded on each passage of the Finish Line.

### ARTICLE 10. PRIZE MONEY

A Grand Total of 27,000 MYR (approximately 6,000 Euros Subject to Exchange Rates) will be awarded in prize money. Prizes shall be paid to the beneficiaries after the finish of the race.

### ARTICLE 11. ANTI-DOPING

The UCI anti-doping regulations are entirely applicable to the event. Riders and Teams Official must check and be aware whether they are required for any daily anti-doping controls. Doping control test will take place after the finish of each Stage at a location indicated in race manual close to the Finish Line.

### ARTICLE 12. AWARDS CEREMONY/PROTOCOL

The following riders must attend the official awards ceremony after each Stage Finish:

- The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed riders
- Best Asian Rider 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed riders
- Prime Winners

The riders present themselves at the podium promptly after crossing the finish line.

## Specific Regulations

### ARTICLE 13. PENALTIES

The UCI penalty scale is the only one applicable.

### ARTICLES 14. CYCLING AND THE ENVIRONMENT

The Organiser would like to remind all parties involved in the race to be sensitive to environment concerns. There will be sufficient Waste Bins and Portable Toilets at the Start and Finish Area.

There will be strictly no littering at Hotel Car Parks, Start/Finish Area, Feed Zones and throughout the Race Circuit. All refuse is to be disposed in a responsible and hygienic manner. Penalties will be applied.

\*\* Please be reminded that causing damage to the flora and fauna is strictly prohibited.

### ARTICLE 15. Etiquette and Image

Malaysia is a strict Muslim Country, the organisation considers the preservation of its image, and reputation of the Event to be very important. The Organiser reserves the right to refuse participation or to exclude from the event, any Team or Team members whose presence or actions shall damage this.

The Organiser may exclude a Team/Rider or Team Member in the following cases.

- A breach of Malaysian Law
- Acts of aggression in or outside the race
- Indecent attire or inappropriate behaviour
